


## SERVICE BULLETIN #125500

Subject: Plunger Bushing Installation

Tools Needed: Vice grip, 3/16 Allen Wrench, Drill, 1/2" drill bit, 15/32" drill bit

**Provided:** Loctite 242



\*Entire main frame is not shown for clarity.

- 1. Remove both socket head cap screws holding adjustment rack with a 3/16 Allen wrench and remove adjustment rack.
- 2. While pulling on knob, grasp plunger with vice grips just below the knob; hold vice grip and twist knob off counter-clockwise. Remove plunger and spring.
- 3. Drill plunger housing. It is recommended to drill a 15/32" hole first, followed by the 1/2" diameter drill bit. Drill the 1/2" diameter hole straight with plunger. Be careful not to drill the hole over size, because of drill wobble.
- 4. Install bushing with flange towards the outside of the plunger. (See Above)
- 5. Insert spring onto plunger. Guide plunger into plunger housing, apply Loctite 242 onto plunger threads and screw knob on clockwise.
- 6. Place Loctite 242 on threads of both socket head cap screws. Thread both screws into adjustment rack at the same time and then tighten.
